SUPPLY CURVE ANALYSIS: JUNE

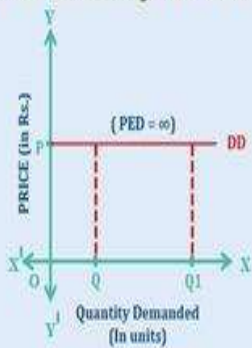
